World Star Student Competition 2008 Award Winners

This international event was held, for the first time, in Tunis with the support of the World Packaging Organisation (WPO), in order to recognize student’s creativity and innovation in the field of packaging all over the world.

Six criteria were taken into account to judge packaging projects such as ; the degree of innovation, sales appeal and graphics, environmental compliance, ease of processing and manufacturing, compliance with the packed product and overall impression.

This fourth edition attracted 200 projects from 15 countries around the world. 3 projects received the title of **“Student World Star 2008”**, 10 projects were given Honourable Mention Prize and 141 projects which had a score higher then 100 points were given Certificate of Recognition.
